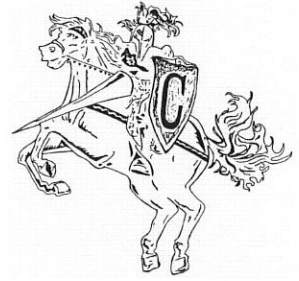

Dear Students and Parents:

Although we just finished the school year, we are busy planning for the 2011-2012 school year. As seniors, I know that many of you are looking forward to the opportunity to park on campus. Enclosed is a copy of the "Parking on the Chariho Campus" policy. It provides detailed information about the guidelines that must be met for students to qualify for a parking permit (see Section II. C. 1 and 2). Parking permits will be issued by lottery to qualified seniors. If the policy guidelines have been met, including the Graduation Portfolio benchmark, eligible students must provide the following information:

1. Copy of student's valid Rhode Island driver's license
2. Make and color of car
3. Copy of current insurance card
4. Copy of current Rhode Island registration
5. Check for \$25.00 made payable to Chariho Parking #213

This information must be mailed and postmarked by **Friday, July 29, 2011** to:

Incomplete or outdated information (e.g., expired insurance card or registration) **will be returned to the sender, and these students will not be eligible for the initial lottery.** The lottery will take place during the first week in August. A listing of the seniors whose names were selected for parking permits will be posted on the high school link of the Chariho website (www.chariho.k12.ri.us) during the following week.

Student parking permits will be issued on August 31st and September 1st and 2nd between the hours of 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM in the Deans' Office (A3). All "Parking on the Chariho Campus" policy guidelines must be met in order for students to continue parking on campus during the school year. Qualified students not issued a parking permit will be put on a waiting list, and a lottery will be held when spaces become available.
